



Harmons' Give-a-Gobble Gifts Record Donation to Utah Food Bank

West Valley City, Utah, December 18, 2020—Generous donations from Harmons' customers and associates netted a record-breaking donation of \$294,000 in funds and meals to Utah Food Bank during its annual Give-a-Gobble fundraiser.

Every year during the month of November, Harmons customers donate at checkout registers to help feed Utah families with Harmons pledging to donate a matching amount. This year Harmons doubled its annual match and pledged \$20,000.

A portion of donations from Give-a-Gobble go toward Thanksgiving meals. This year, 3,000 holiday meals were distributed to families in need the day before Thanksgiving during the annual "Turkey Toss" food distribution event at the Urban Indian Center of Salt Lake City. And more than \$225,000 cash gift was donated to Utah Food Bank.

"With 511,000 Utahns facing hunger, this donation comes at a crucial time. Harmons also participates in the Grocery Rescue program where consumable but nonsalable food is donated weekly to Utah Food Bank for distribution throughout the state.
